Notes for THOMAS Jefferson McKee:

The following story was written in the early 1940's by Jesse Elijah McKee, grandson of Thomas Jefferson McKee and son of John Wesley McKee. It was presented at a family reunion July 27, 1958.

History of Thomas Jefferson McKee

Of course, the older members of our family know something of our family history, but I feel quite confident that there are a great number of you present today that know very little of the early history of the McKee family; so I am proud to tell you some of the facts concerning the family, and here I want to say that I am proud of our name; I'm proud to be a McKee; I am proud to be kin to the McKee's.

There are a great many descendants of our "Illustrious Grandfather", Thomas Jefferson McKee, who is a grandfather to some of us here today, and who is a great grandfather to a large number of you here and is a great-great grandfather to a large number of the youngsters present; and perhaps is a great-great-great grandfather to some present.

Thomas Jefferson McKee was born in South Carolina on March 5th, 1814. We do not know what his father's given name was, nor where or when he was born, however it is a family legend that there were three brothers who came to this country as lads from Scotland and one of these brothers was Thomas Jefferson McKee's father. Time of their arrival must have not been later than the year 1800. We do not know Thomas Jefferson's mother's name nor anything concerning her. We do know that he had three brothers whose names were Luther, John and Robert. His brother John McKee came to Texas and settled near Emory in Rains County which is over in East Texas. Where the two brothers, Luther and Robert settled, we do not know.

We can find no record of the early life of Thomas Jefferson McKee. We don't know in what community he grew to manhood; neither do we know anything about his courtship with Dina Winters, his first wife; nor have we been able to ascertain the date of their marriage. We do know from this marriage were born ten children; five boys and five girls. Dina died about 1855 and is buried in Newton County, Mississippi. The names of the ten children by his first wife are Jim, Sarah Jane, Ellen, Malissia, Alanzo (Kern) Julia, Trissia, Thomas, Carr and Clark.

In 1856 Thomas Jefferson McKee married his second wife, Prissella Long in Newton County, Mississippi. From this marriage there were born three children. Two boys and one girl and one of these boys, Uncle George McKee is still living at Killleen, Bell County, Texas, (and is here today with us) and it is from him that we are indebted for the most of the information which I am giving you. Priscella died in 1863 and is buried at Zion Church Cemetery in Mississippi. The names of the three children by his second wife are George, Henry and Rio.

In 1864 Thomas Jefferson McKee married for the third time. His third wife was Mrs. Nancy Walker Smith. They were married at her home in Newton County, Mississippi. From the third marriage there were born seven children; five girls and two boys. This makes a grand total of twenty (20) children from his three marriages. None of which were boys and eleven were girls. All lived to maturity. The names of the seven children by his third wife are Emma, Katherine, John, Blake, Frankie, Crawford and Robert.

Thomas Jefferson McKee was a soldier in the Confederate Army in the War Between the States; although he was 47 years of age when the war began. Some of his older sons were also soldiers in the Confederate Army, but we do not have their record at this time, but do hope to secure their war record later. We have some information from the Department of Archives and History from the State of Mississippi which tells us that his Company was the 46th Regiment of Infantry of the 6th Battalion and that he was a private in Company 1. His Company was mustered from Newton County, Mississippi and was in the Battle of Chickasaw Bayou, Port Gibson and Vicksburg. How we regret that some one did not make a written record of his war record as he could have told it while he lived. He was captured at the Battle of Vicksburg and was held a prisoner of the Union Army, where and when we do not know. I do have a copy of the oath he took swearing allegiance to the "American

Flag," which we presume he signed upon his release from the Prisoner of War camp. I also have the cap and ball pistol which my father left to me and my father told me that Thomas Jefferson McKee carried it through the Civil War. (This I prize very much.)

Thomas Jefferson McKee left Newton County, Mississippi in the fall of 1867. He had two yoke of oxen hitched to a wagon and two pony mares hitched to a rockaway hack. (Uncle George tells us the names of the mares were Fannie and Fly.) There were several families traveling together on the trip from Mississippi to Texas, but we do not know the names of any of the other families. From the best we can learn, the children that made the trip from Mississippi to Texas were Tom, Carr and Clark, children by his first wife; George, Henry and Rio, children by his second wife, and Emma and Katherine by his third wife. There were also two children of Nancy's, Martha and Mary that made the trip. This makes four different sets of children that came with him in the Ox Wagon and Rockaway hack.

They crossed the Mississippi River at, or near Vicksburg and Thomas Jefferson McKee first came to Hunt County, Texas and lived one year. In the summer of 1868 he made a trip from Hunt to Bell County and rented a place in Keys Valley, paying the sum of Two Hundred Dollars cash rent for it. He returned to Hunt County and that fall moved with his family to Keys Valley, Bell County. (By the way, it's just six (6) miles out to Keys Valley from Belton). The Deed records of Bell County show that he purchased the farm, which he had first rented, in the year of 1871. Here the last of his children were born and reared. He lived in Keys Valley for 18 years; then sold the farm in 1889; at the time he sold, he planned on moving to Devils River, Country in Southwest Texas along the Rio Grande River. However, he was then 75 years of age and he was persuaded to change his mind about going to a new country; so he purchased another place in Stillman Valley in Western Bell County about 20 miles west of Belton; here he lived until his death on August 6th, 1894. He is buried in Keys Valley Cemetery.

I'm glad to have the opportunity of giving you this brief outline of our family history, and I hope that we can soon prepare a complete family tree.[Update McKee Hash to Nancy David Al 10-01.FTW]

Oct 2001- The following was found in STORY OF BELL CO. TEXAS, 976.4 v.1 at the Kileen Library:
"Keys Valley

The land in this secluded valley, named for an early pioneer family, was the first to be inundated for the Stillhouse Hollow Reservoir. The early settlers in Keys Valley were: V.H. Anderson, Fred C. Brookman, William Brookman, W.H. Bruce, William Ferguson, Wesley G. Ferguson, Sam C. Hannon, Hal Keys, Thomas Jefferson McKee, W.L. Pierce, Newton M. Proctor, Sr., Gordon W. Shanklin, and Howell Tatum.

Soon after their arrival, a combination school and church house was erected where children from this valley and from the eastern part of Wilkinson Valley, just across the Lampasas River, attended the one-room school. In the summer time, church services were held under a brush arbor. After the school was consolidated with another district, the Baptists built a house of worship.

As time passed, other families increased the population of Keys Valley. They were named Baggett, Copeland, Damron, Hamilton, McCrackin, Poe, Ross, Safley and Sparks.

Four roads were built by workmen with mule teams from the county. The residents of the valley assisted by providing labor, teams, wagons, picks and shovels for the upkeep of the roads.

The Stillhouse Hollow road, cut from the east side of the hollow, was steep and narrow. It was considered the main road, and farmers going to market with wagon loads of cotton and corn had to rest their teams on the long pull.

The Keys Valley Cemetery was moved to Cedar Knob Cemetery when the government acquired the land for the reservoir.

The Keys Valley Baptist Church was also relocated to Belton." [church east of Belton on south side of the freeway; Cedar Knob Cem. not located on Oct 2001 visit]

James C. McKee is buried in Nolan Cemetery, Nolan County, TX, and I got the dates from his headstone. (His wife and several of his descendents are also buried there.) Others are probably buried in the Sweetwater Cemetery, Nolan County, TX, and some (possibly the girls) may not have migrated with him from Bell County, TX.

In the interest of my poor GG Grandfather "Jim McKee", possibly TJ's first-born son, whom nothing appears to be known about from your chart, I would like to provide additional information. I am new at this so excuse my formatting, and I am unfortunately making a best guess at the names of some of his children since their names are from varying accounts. His complete name was James Chandler McKee, but he went by Jim (Jamie on one census). He followed TJ to MS and TX, fought for the Confederacy, and moved on to be one of the early farmer settlers in Nolan County, TX, which is where he is buried. He was supposed to have had 12 children (but I have collected 14 names--My research is still ongoing). I did not attempt to name his children's descendents since I don't know for sure the relationships, and some living descendants may not want to be listed or have their parents listed. But it is a place to start for those that don't have much information on him.

On the 1880 Census, he said his mother, Dina Winters, was born in England, and as one of her older children, he should know more about her than the younger ones.
